

Local Health Department (LHD)

Checklist for Suspected EBOLA Case

Upon arrival to LHD...

1. If the individual has history of exposure to a person with Ebola **OR** has traveled during the past 3 weeks (21 days) from one of the following affected countries in West Africa:
 - Liberia
 - Guinea
 - Sierra Leone
2. And is displaying the following symptoms:
 - Fever (subjective or $\geq 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$ or $\geq 38^{\circ}\text{C}$)
 - Headache
 - Weakness
 - Muscle pain
 - Diarrhea
 - Vomiting
 - Abdominal pain or hemorrhage
3. ***Isolate the individual in a private room. Institute standard, contact and droplet precautions using the highest level of PPE available.***

Consult KDPH...

1. Contact KDPH at **1-888-9REPORT**.
2. Await further instructions.
3. Do not panic, Ebola **IS NOT** spread through:
 - Casual contact
 - Air
 - Water
 - Food
2. Ebola **IS ONLY** spread through direct contact with:
 - Blood
 - Body fluids (urine, feces, saliva, vomit, sweat, breast milk, and semen)
 - Objects, like needles, that have been contaminated with blood or body fluids of a person with Ebola.
